Norwegian bassist Mats Eilertsen has been a distinctive presence on recordings by the likes of Tord Gustavsen, Trygve Seim, Mathias Eick, Nils Økland and Jakob Young and has recorded for amongst others ECM and Hubro. The vocal ensemble Trio Mediæval was founded by Linn Andrea Fuglseth in Oslo in 1997. The trio's core repertoire features sacred monophonic and polyphonic medieval music from England, Italy and France, contemporary works written for the ensemble, as well as traditional Norwegian, Swedish and Icelandic ballads and songs, mostly arranged by the group members. During the last eight years, the trio has developed exciting collaborations with both individual musicians as well as larger ensembles/orchestras.
