MULTIVERSE have created a musical language based on intuitive interplay, attentive communication and musical eclecticism in coalition with ideas on tonal, rhythmic and compositional structures that can truthfully be stated to be their own. The band has a distinct jazz attitude about their music, while leaning just as easily toward classical modernism with references such as Ravel and Messiaen or Eastern influences from India and the Middle-East. The music is performed with great improvisational freedom and tight interplay between musicians that each on their own have established as prominent voices in contemporary Nordic jazz. Multiverse is the idea of parallel universes; in this case five personal, musical microuniverses that through interplay make up the patchwork of impulses in their own multiverse.
